Program Learn and Play:

Počet dětí navštěvujících kurzy Learn and Play je relativně nízký (max. 8 dětí), což umožňuje lektorovi pracovat s dětmi na osobnější bázi a být schopen zhodnotit a věnovat se jejich konkrétním potřebám. Lekce se zaměřují na komunikaci a tvorbu sebevědomí, ale v pozdějším věku zároveň i na schopnost čtení a psaní. Menší počet dětí ve skupince umožňuje učitelům vést děti k tomu, aby využívaly svých znalostí v nenucené a zábavné atmosféře. Lekce jsou složeny především z her, říkanek, písniček tak, aby si děti co nejvíce zapamatovaly slovní zásobu a osvojily si jednoduchá slovní spojení a věty.

Please X Thank you.</p>	<p>Flashcard race: Use the clues given by the lector to get to the flashcard the fastest.</p> <p>Draw race: Draw a picture of one of the topic words. The picture must be drawn nicely and quickly. Then the erasing game (erase correct word fastest as much you can).</p> <p>Balancing Chairs: The children make 2 teams and answer what vocabulary is on a flashcard. The winner takes the flashcard and loser must stack a chair. If the pile of chairs falls, that time wins.</p> <p>Activity: Spin the Twister board to get either drawing, hangman, pantomime, speaking.
