Počet dětí navštěvujících kurzy Learn and Play je maximálně 8, což umožňuje lektorovi pracovat s dětmi na osobnější bázi a být schopen zhodnotit a věnovat se jejich konkrétním potřebám. Lekce se zaměřují na komunikaci a tvorbu sebedůvěry, ale v pozdějším věku zároveň i na schopnost čtení a psaní. Menší počet dětí ve skupince umožňuje učiteli vést děti k tomu, aby využívaly svých znalostí v nenucené a zábavné atmosféře. Lekce jsou složeny především z her, říkanek, písniček tak, aby si děti co nejvíce zapamatovaly slovní zásobu a osvojily si jednoduchá slovní spojení a věty.

An inventor?</p> <p>Orders: Hello Sit down Stand up Get a pillow Make a circle Where is the... Good bye</p>	<p>Association: The students answer questions or what vocabulary is on a card. Whoever is first gets to roll a dice and see how many puzzle pieces they can collect (up to 6). The team to complete the most puzzles is the winner.</p> <p>Headband game: Students try to guess what famous person they are based on yes or no questions. E.g: Am I am man? Am I real? The student with the most correct guesses wins.</p> <p>Trivia: Students guess what famous person from the lesson the lector is talking about. There are three rounds: first speaking, second pictures of famous people, and the third is voices of famous people that we studied. Student with the most points wins.</p>
