Počet dětí navštěvujících kurzy Learn and Play je maximálně 8, což umožňuje lektorovi pracovat s dětmi na osobnější bázi a být schopen zhodnotit a věnovat se jejich konkrétním potřebám. Lekce se zaměřují na komunikaci a tvorbu sebedůvěry, ale v pozdějším věku zároveň i na schopnost čtení a psaní. Menší počet dětí ve skupince umožňuje učiteli vést děti k tomu, aby využívaly svých znalostí v nenucené a zábavné atmosféře. Lekce jsou složeny především z her, říkanek, písniček tak, aby si děti co nejvíce zapamatovaly slovní zásobu a osvojily si jednoduchá slovní spojení a věty.

<p>Holidays: New Year's Day, Chinese New Year, Valentine's Day, St. Patrick's Day, April Fool's Day, Easter, May Day, Labor Day, Victory Day, Mother's Day, Christmas, Cinco De Mayo, Thanksgiving, Independence Day.</p> <p>Family Feud: Students take guesses on what is the most popular answer as given by Americans. E.g. The most popular things to do in summer: Going to the beach, going to the cinema, etc. The team with the most correct answers win.</p> <p>Christmas: Christmas Tree, present, bell, candles, Santa Claus, ornament, star, snowman, snowflake, reindeer, sleigh, stocking, wreath, mistletoe, holly.</p>	<p>Phrases: What is your favorite holiday? What is the color you should wear for St. Patrick's Day? What holiday has to do with love? Do you like Christmas? Do you have a Christmas Tree at home? What present do you want? What color are your ornaments? How many candles are there for Advent?</p> <p>Orders: Hello Sit down Stand up Get a pillow Make a circle Where is the... Good bye</p>	<p>Association: The students answer questions or what vocabulary is on a card. Whoever is first gets to roll a dice and see how many puzzle pieces they can collect (up to 6). The team to complete the most puzzles is the winner.</p> <p>Activity: Students roll a dice that has a different activity (molding, drawing, pantomime). They have one minute to have their teammate guess what vocabulary word they are indicating. The time to reach 20 cards wins the game.</p> <p>Action Race: The students make 2 groups and must race and pantomime a vocabulary word while obeying the orders of stop and go. The team who finishes gets the card.</p> <p>Worksheets: Video About Christmas traditions in other countries.</p>
