## **Program Learn and Play:**

Počet dětí navštěvujících kurzy Learn and Play je maximálně 8, což umožňuje lektorovi pracovat s dětmi na osobnější bázi a být schopen zhodnotiť a věnovat se jejich konkrétním potřebám. Lekce se zaměřují na komunikaci a tvorbu sebedůvěry, ale v pozdějším věku zároveň i na schopnost čtení a psaní. Menší počet dětí ve skupince umožňuje učiteli vést děti k tomu, aby využívaly svých znalostí v nenucené a zábavné atmosféře. Lekce jsou složeny především z her, říkanek, písniček tak, aby si děti co nejvíce zapamatovaly slovní zásobu a osvojily si jednoduchá slovní spojení a věty.

Insects: Bee, snail, ladybug, tick, spider, butterfly, fly, caterpillar, grasshopper, ant, wasp, dragonfly, firefly, beetle, stick-bug, moth, scorpion, mosquito.	Phrases: What are insects? Orders: Hello Sit down Stand up Get a pillow Make a circle Where is the Good bye	"Where is" game: Students look at a group of cards and find the correct card. The person with the most cards wins.  Pictionary: Students draw a vocabulary word while the other students try to guess what vocabulary they are indicating.  Grill Party: Students answer the word on a vocabulary card. If they're right, they pick a card and must place the food on a plastic grill. They person with the most cards wins.  Battle Boats: Students answer what vocabulary they see or answer a question. The first team to answer get to shoot a ball at a plastic ship. The first team to get all of ships out of the opposing team's side wins.  Insect Worksheet: Students mark how many legs, wings, and antennas an insect has and draw it.
