<p>Actions: Running, jumping, playing, climbing, dancing, writing, clapping, counting, throwing, walking, talking, eating, sitting.</p> <p>Adjectives: Big-Small, Tall-Short, Clean-Dirty, High-Low, Long-Short, Wet-Dry, Slow-Fast, Full-Empty, Beautiful-Ugly, Old-New, Heavy-Light, On-Off.</p> <p>Traveling: Suitcase, passport, ticket, blanket, tent, campfire, sleeping bag, suitcase, tourist, camera, traveling, toothbrush, rope, flashlight.</p>	<p>Phrases: What do you like to write? Do you like playing? What do you like to play? Is an elephant big or small? <i>Big.</i> Is the cup full or empty?...<i>full.</i> What do you need to cook your food while you are camping?...<i>campfire.</i> What do you put inside your suitcase?...<i>clothes, shoes, and toothbrush.</i> What do you need at night when it is dark?...<i>flashlight.</i></p> <p>Orders: Sit down in a circle. Put away your pillows. Stand up. Pay attention. Hold hands.</p>	<p>Battleship: I show each child in turn a card and if they say it correctly they get to shoot the cannon and try to sink the ships. The winner is the one who sinks the most ships.</p> <p>Shuffling card game: I assign each child a card that they must watch carefully. I then turn their cards upside down and shuffle them around while they keep track of where their card is. When I stop they must point to where their card is and tell me what it is.</p> <p>Jenga: I split the students into two teams and select one person from each team. I then show them a flash card, and the one who says it first does not have to play. The one who said it second has to take a block from the tower. The team who makes the tower fall over loses.</p> <p>Bed Bugs: I show each student two vocabulary cards and after they say them correctly they get to take tweezers and they have 10 seconds to grab as many jumping bugs as they can. The winner is the one who has the most bugs.</p>
