Lekce se zaměřují na komunikaci a tvorbu sebedůvěry, ale v pozdějším věku zároveň i na schopnost čtení a psaní. Lekce jsou složeny především z her, říkanek, písniček tak, aby si děti co nejvíce zapamatovaly slovní zásobu a osvojily si jednoduchá slovní spojení a věty.

Stand up. Come here please. Take a pillow – make a circle. Draw x write x color. Fast and nice.</p>	<p>Flashcard race: Use the clues given by the lector to get to the flashcard the fastest.</p> <p>Pins: Students listen to the vocabulary or a clue and use a ball to knock down a pin that has the correct flashcard. The team with the most cards wins.</p> <p>Pairs: The students answer what vocabulary is indicated in the picture or by clues. The winner or if they know what it is get to find a pair. The students with the most pairs wins.</p> <p>Poker: Using the chips from the game of pairs, students place bets based on their confidence in their knowledge of the vocab.
