### **Program English Time:**

Děti jsou do lekce angličtiny vtahovány hrami, soutěžemi ve dvojicích, v týmech i samostatnou prací. Postupně se seznamují i s psaným jazykem. The one with the most points wins.</p> <p><b>Monkey flying:</b> I show them a card and the one who guesses it first gets to shoot a monkey from a catapult and try to make it hook on the tree. The winner is the one with the most monkeys on the tree.</p> <p><b>Stacking chairs:</b> The kids divide up into two teams. One kid from each team gets a chance to guess a card . The one who doesn't guess it has to place a chair on the stack of other chairs. The team that makes the stack fall over loses.</p> <p><b>JENGA:</b> There is a tower of rectangular blocks stacked up. I show them a flash card and the one who guesses the card does not have to remove a block but the one who didn't say the card has to remove a block. The one who removes a block and causes the tower to fall loses.</p>
