<p>Fruit: Banana, apple, orange, kiwi.</p> <p>Vegetables: Onion, tomato, potato, pepper, mushroom, cucumber, broccoli, corn, carrot, leek.</p> <p>Sweets: Ice cream, chocolate, cookies, candy, lollipop, sugar, cake.</p> <p>Drinks: Water, soda, tea, coffee, juice.</p> <p>Dairy: Milk, butter, yogurt, cheese.</p> <p>Meat: Sausage, chicken, pork, fish.</p>	<p>Phrases: Do you like banana?</p> <p>I like...</p> <p>I don't like...</p> <p>What color are tomatoes?</p> <p>Where is a mushroom?</p> <p>Is ice cream a vegetable?</p> <p>Orders: Hello, Everyone. Sit down. Stand up. Come here, please. Wash your hands. Sit in a circle. Stop. Go. Please. Thank you. How many...? What color?</p>	<p>Flashcard race: Use the clues given by the lector to get to the flashcard the fastest.</p> <p>Draw race: Draw a picture of one of the topic words. The picture must be drawn nicely and quickly. Then the erasing game (erase correct word fastest as much you can).</p> <p>BBQ Party: Whoever gets the vocabulary answer right gets to put on or take off a piece of food onto a toy grill, which can pop off. Whoever gets the most cards and food figures wins the game.</p> <p>Shopping race: Each child gets a basket and tries to find the correct food to take with them. They also obey the command of "stop" and "go".</p> <p>Pairs/Vocab Poker: Students answer questions about the vocabulary or what is on a flashcard. The winner tries to find pairs. After the game is finished the students use their pairs as chips to bet on their answers. The student or team who loses all their chips is the loser.</p> <p>Arts and Crafts: Color what's in the fridge. Paper roll candy.</p>
