Děti jsou do lekce angličtiny vtahovány hrami, soutěžemi ve dvojicích, v týmech i samostatnou prací. Postupně se seznamují i s psaným jazykem. K seznamování dochází postupně a nenásilně v několika krocích. Tato metoda je tak vhodná i pro výuku angličtiny pro dyslektiky a dysgrafiky. Lektor v lekcích vytváří přátelskou atmosféru, vede děti k vzájemné spolupráci a motivuje je k vlastnímu vyjádření.

Students roll a dice and get either pantomime, sculpting, or drawing with their eyes closed. They must make the other person on their team understand a vocabulary word or word from the game cards. The team with the most cards wins.</p> <p>Holidays (Start): Easter, Halloween, Mother's Day, New Year's Day, St. Patrick's Day, Christmas/Hanakkah, Labor Day, May Day.</p>	<p>Phrases: Is an elephant big or small? What holiday happens on January first?</p> <p>Orders: Hello Sit down Stand up Get a pillow Make a circle Where is the... Good bye</p>	<p>Time's up: Students are split into teams and segments. The first round is whole sentences, second round one word, and third round pantomime. The team with the most points or cards wins.</p> <p>Battle Boats: Students answer what vocabulary they see or answer a question. The first team to answer get to shoot a ball at a plastic ship. The first team to get all of ships out of the opposing team's side wins.</p> <p>Molding: Students use a piece of clay to try and represent a vocabulary word. The first time to guess correctly gets point.</p> <p>Worksheet: Adjective Worksheet: Students draw and write a sentence about an adjective. For example, Elephants are big.</p>
