Play on teams.</p>	<p>Flashcard race: Use the clues given by the lector to get to the flashcard the fastest.</p> <p>Draw race: Draw a picture of one of the topic words. The picture must be drawn nicely and quickly. Then the erasing game.</p> <p>Battle Boats: Students answer questions or give the name of the object on a card. The winner gets the opportunity to shoot a toy boat off of a 3D board. The first team to shoot all the boats out wins. The loser gives up 3 cards.</p> <p>Balancing Chairs: Answer a question about the vocabulary and get a card for the right answer. If you had the wrong answer or didn't answer on time you have to stack a toy chair on a pile if it falls you lose 2 points.</p>
